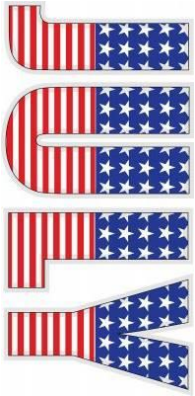

The next Board meeting will be Wednesday, September 5, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the church library.

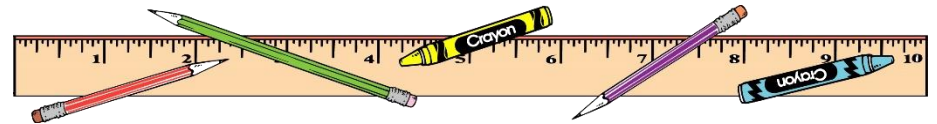
The meeting closed with the board members praying together "The Lord's Prayer."
